- After receiving the Advisory Committee's update and recommendation, Chairman Liner MOVED to have Elementary Students transition to four days of in person instruction on October 12, 2020, with Middle School and High School Students transitioning to four days of in person instruction on October 26, 2020, with all schools returning to five days a week of instruction on Wednesday, November 4, 2020 (Schools are closed on November 2, for Parent/Teacher Conferences and on November 3, for Election Day); SECONDED by Mr. Smith; MOTION passed on a vote of 7-2 (Mr. Nuessle and Ms. Rhinehart-Jackson opposed)
