PROGRESS SUMMARY:

The contractor commenced operations on site on January 2. During the past month, the contractor has completed the low-slope roofing, set the air handling units, chillers, and kitchen hood. Exterior masonry has been cleaned. The progress of the work is behind the published schedule. Completion is currently estimated as 30 days past the Contract Time.
