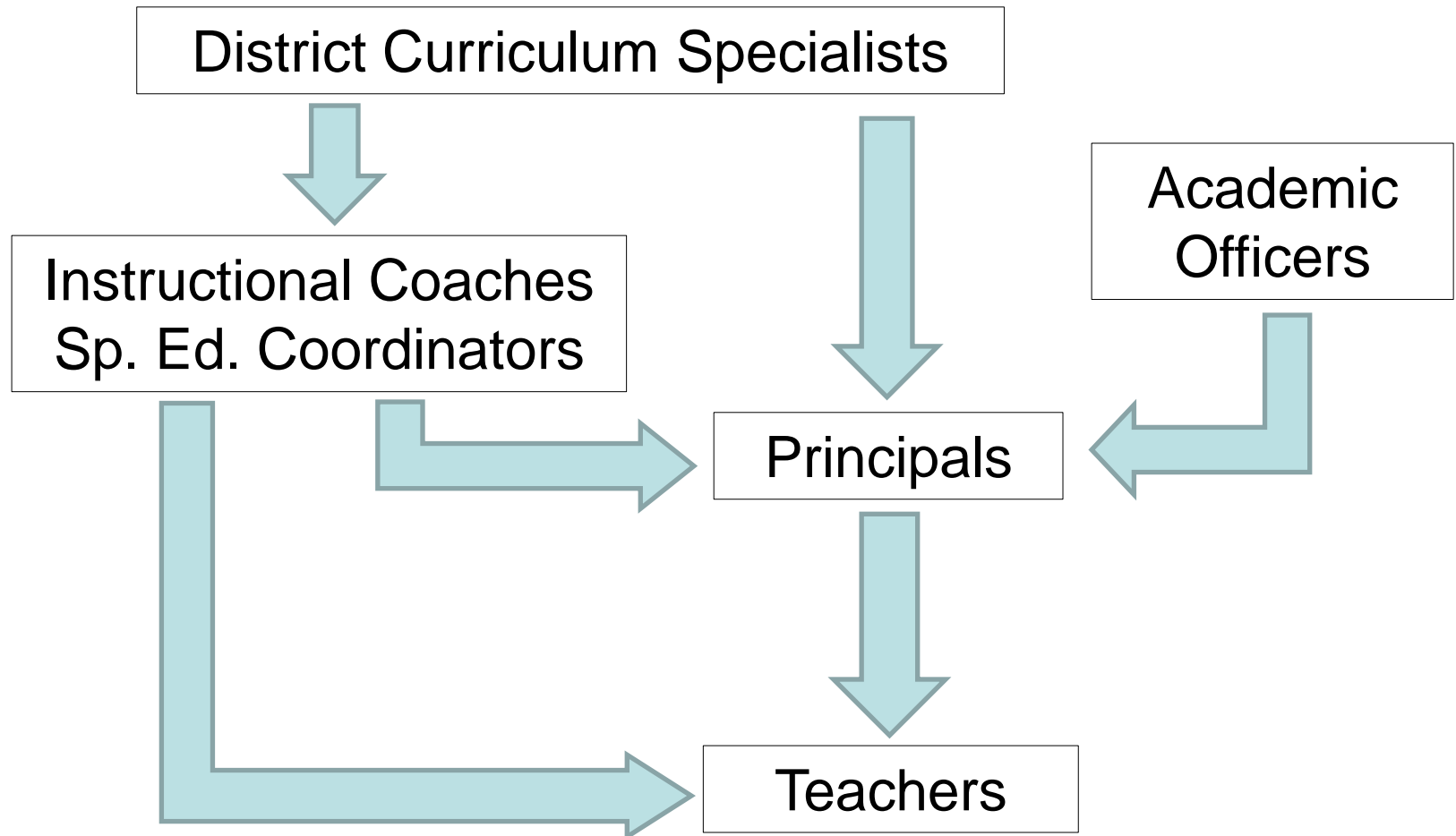


- Continue many of the same initiatives
