State Board Regulation 43-261 and School Board Policy ADA

- Each school district must develop a five-year district strategic plan
- Each school must develop a five-year school renewal plan
- District and school plans shall coordinate and align improvement initiatives.



Strategic Planning Process


- Demonstrate a commitment to continuous improvement
- Respond to accountability requirements in both state and federal legislation
- Develop the plan collaboratively with a broadbased group of stakeholders



Strategic Plan Priorities and Efforts

- Raising student achievement levels for all students
- Preventing academic problems
- Reducing the achievement gaps identified on the annual report card from state assessments

- Comprehensive Needs Assessment
- Performance Goals / Interim Goals
 - o Student Achievement
 - o Teacher Quality
 - o School Climate
- Strategies and Action Plans
- Evaluation of Strategies
- Evidence of Comprehensive Consensus Building
- Assurances
