# Current State of the School

---

The original structure was built in 1939.

Antiquated HVAC system would require complete replacement to meet air quality requirements.

No air in the hallways which contributes to substantial temperature differences between hallways and classrooms.

Limited electrical outlets throughout the building to support current classroom technology.

Recurring repairs and maintenance of roof leaks, despite the roof being replaced 10 years ago

Poor ventilation and moisture in certain areas contribute to recurring mold issues.

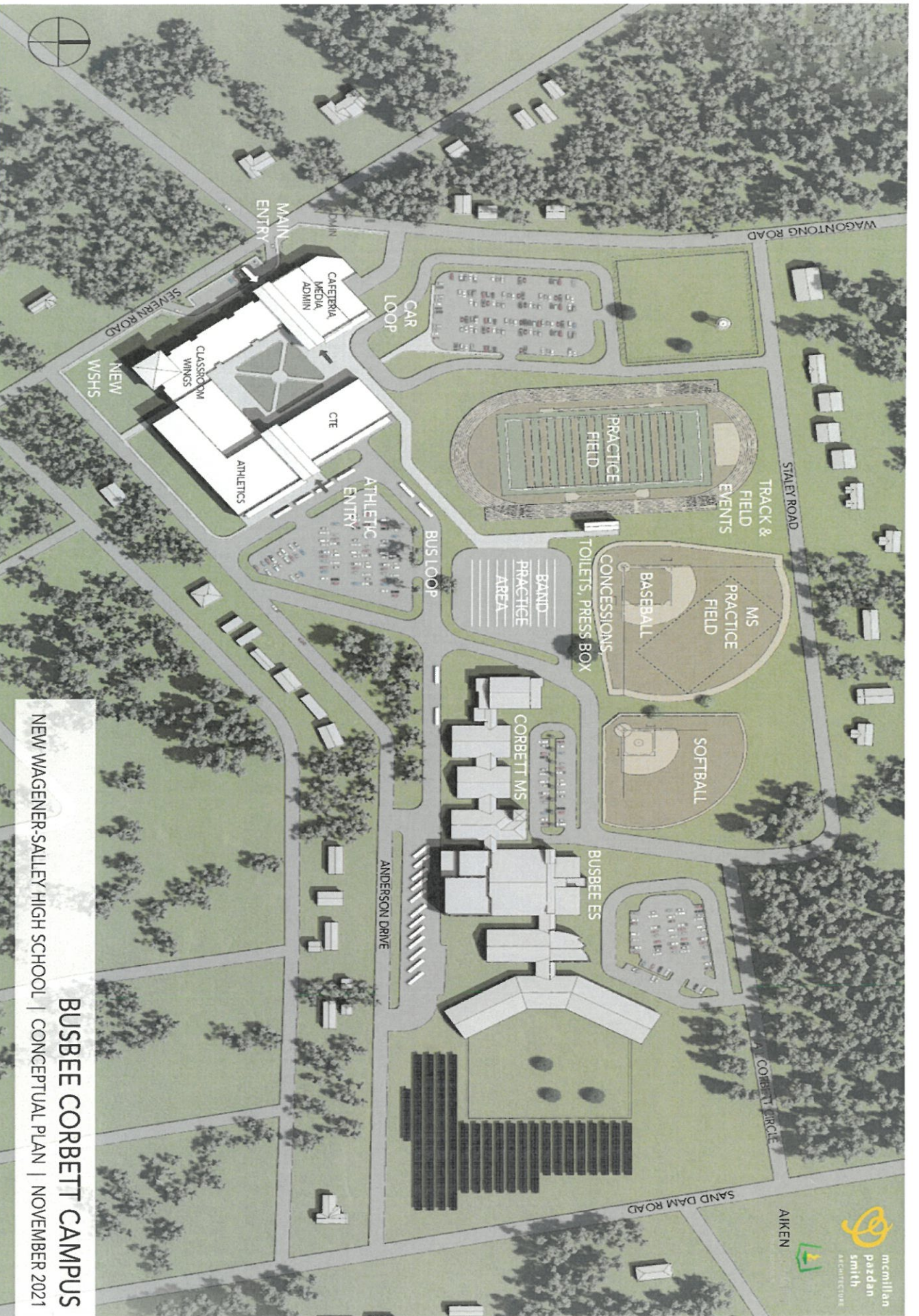

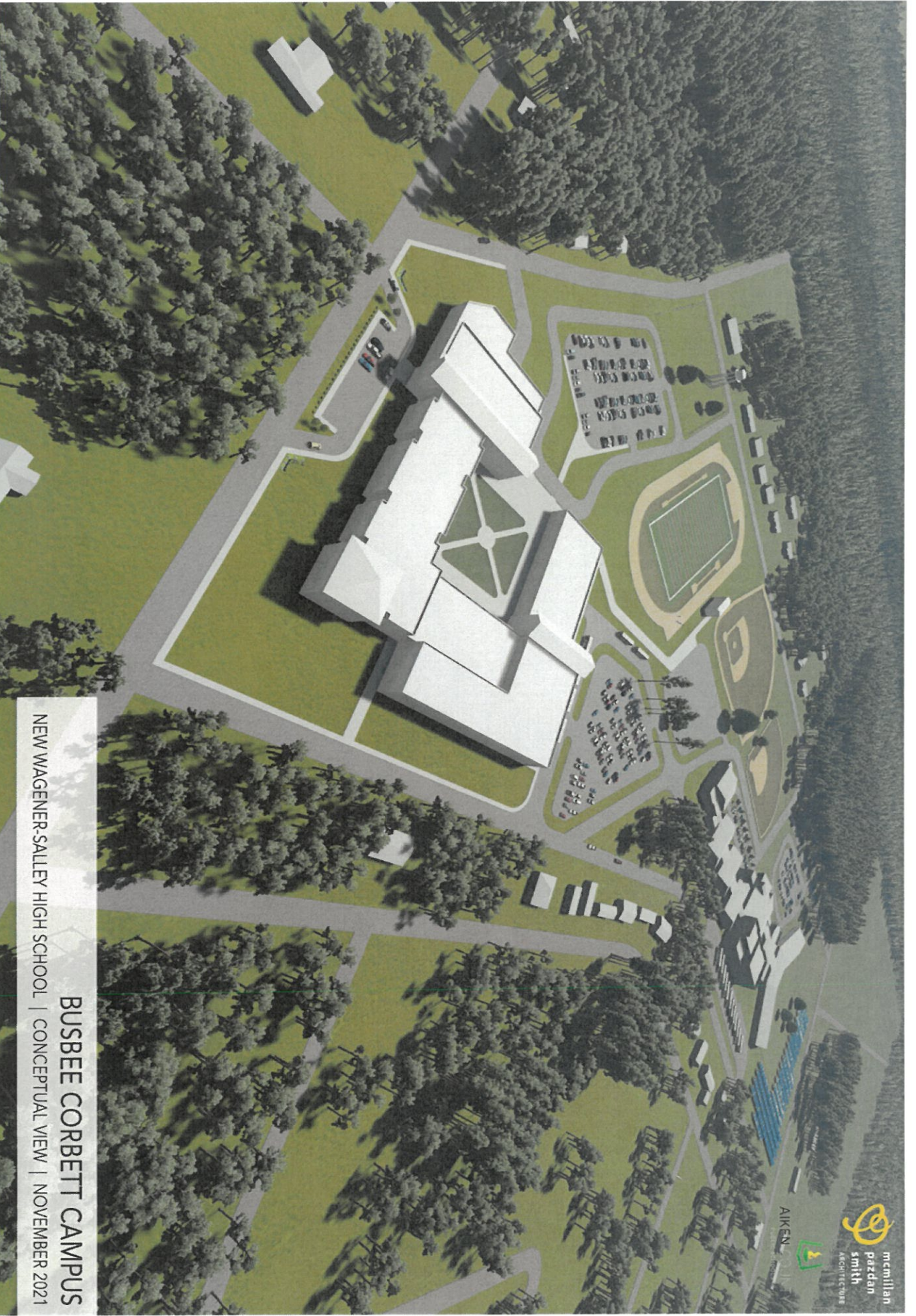

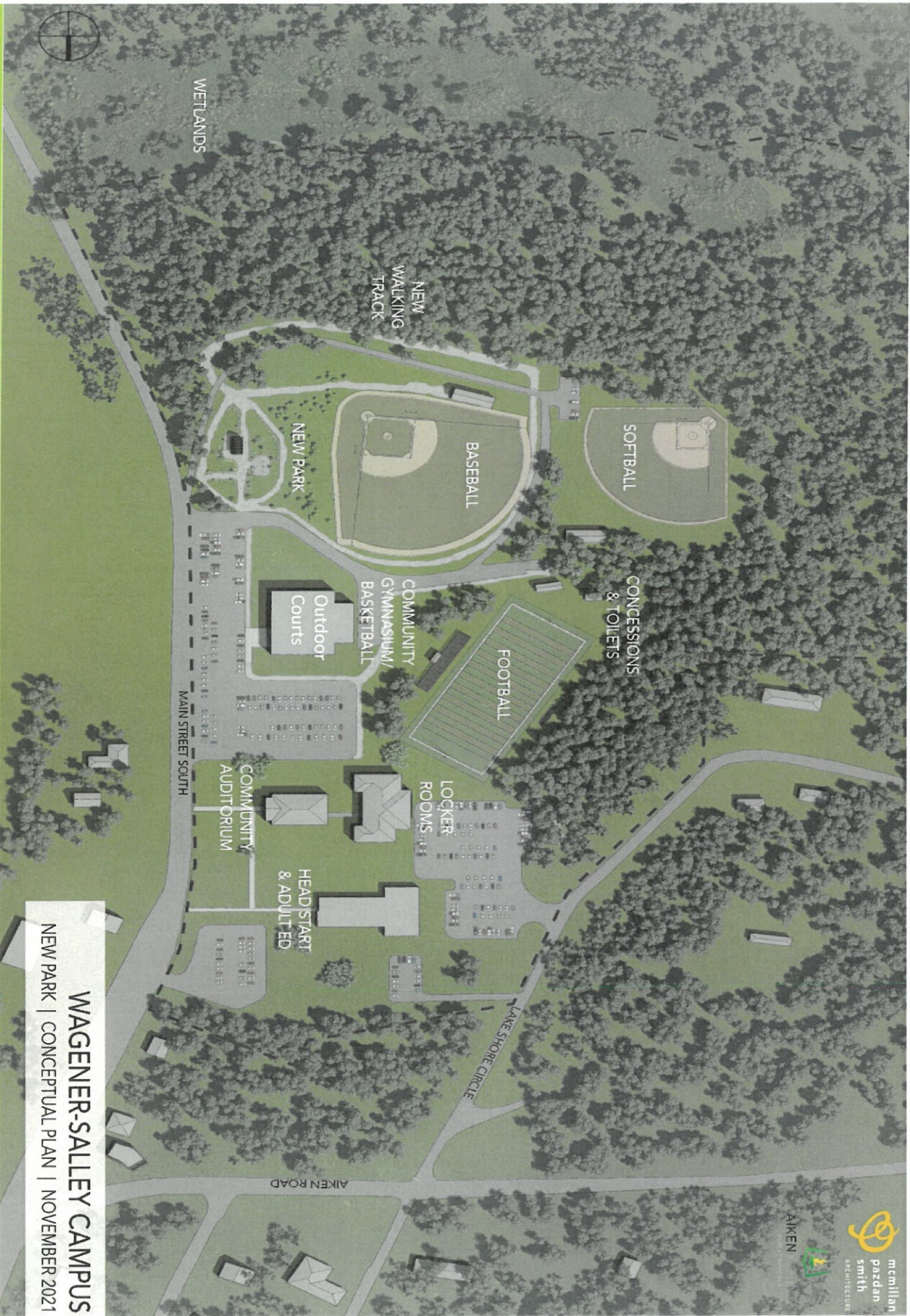
