Curriculum development and the implementation of change...require close cooperation of instructional personnel and relevant others as well as continuous research, experimentation, and critical analysis.

The official process for accomplishing curriculum development requires the involvement of professional staff members who use the curriculum and are responsible for its implementation.



Curriculum Vision

Aiken County Public Schools' curriculum will be a searchable resource (virtual document) that teachers are required to use to:

- inform their instruction specific to the sequence and pacing in which standards will be taught;
- link to supporting resources;
- access model lessons with strategies for engaging students and differentiating instruction;
- access benchmark assessments (formative and summative) with exemplar, rigorous questions or open-ended tasks that determine mastery of targeted standards.


