Test Scores - Release Dates

ACT (Wednesday, 12:01 a.m., August 17) - This is a national embargo run by the ACT organization.

SAT/AP (Late August or early to mid-September) – The College Board has not set a date for its national release, which covers SAT and Advanced Placement exam scores.

EAA SCHOOL REPORT CARDS (Thursday, November 10, 12:01 a.m.) – School districts will receive preview access to embargoed Report Card data on Wednesday, November 2.

There are no release dates yet for **HSAP, EOCEP** or local high school **AP** scores, all of which are released as data are finalized. The state is targeting **mid-September on HSAP, mid-October for EOCEP, and local-level AP** scores as quickly as they can get them from the College Board.
