SUBJECT:

Consideration of ARP ESSER Spending Revision #5

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The American Rescue Plan (ARP) was signed into law on March 11, 2021. The SC Department of Education (SCDE) was allocated approximately \$2.1 billion in Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) funds from ARP. Aiken is allocated \$63,386,401. Funds must be spent by September 30, 2024, within 15 allowable use categories.

ADMINISTRATIVE CONSIDERATION:

The Administration proposes what is expected to be its final ARP ESSER amendment as the September 30, 2024, deadline approaches.

This amendment shifts funds from learning loss (having met the requirement to spend at least 20% on learning loss), audio enhancement (with final payments to be made from 8% funds due to finalization expected to fall after September 30, 2024), employee assistant program (covered by the General Fund in 2024 – 2025), indirect cost (as closeout since indirect cost would not relate to remaining anticipated costs) to the Wagener-Salley construction project (increasing the ESSER-funded portion from \$25.9 million to \$29.8 million).
