SUBJECT:

Items Declared Surplus and Method of Disposal

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Miscellaneous furnishings and equipment have been screened and determined to be obsolete and no longer of use to the District. Board approval is necessary for the disposal of these items (Procurement Regulations: Surplus Management XXVII, C,1).

ADMINSTRATIVE CONSIDERATION:

The Procurement Code dictates that Board approval is required to declare items found unusable to the District as surplus. The Board must also approve the method of disposal of the surplus items. All proceeds received from the sale of surplus items shall be deposited into the District's General Fund.

RECOMMENDATION:

Declare items surplus and authorize the Administration to dispose of items by public auction. It also recommended that the District contract with an experienced auctioneer service to conduct the surplus auction.
