SUBJECT:

Approval of Comprehensive Health Education (CHE) Advisory Committee

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Comprehensive Health Education Act of 1988 requires that each school board appoint a CHE advisory committee to assist in the selection of curriculum support components and materials. This committee must consist of two parents, three clergy, two health professionals, two teachers, two students, and two persons not employed by the school district. Each district advisory committee must review all reproductive health education, family life education, and pregnancy prevention education materials before they are used in the schools.

ADMINISTRATIVE CONSIDERATION:

District personnel reviewed the current list of advisory committee members and found a need to add one additional clergy to satisfy the state's requirement for the committee's makeup.

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the recommended individuals to serve on the Comprehensive Health Education Advisory Committee
