SUBJECT:

Public Education Partners (PEP) of Aiken County Grant Awards to the Aiken County Public School District – FY22

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Aiken County Public School District has been given a \$3,831.34 in grant awards from the Public Education Partners (PEP) of Aiken County. The funds received will be used to fund seven teacher grant awards. After evaluating all of the grant applications submitted to PEP, seven projects were selected to receive awards. These grant awards total \$3,831.34 with \$2,634.34 of them related to STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math). The funds are to be used by the awardee teachers to carry out the projects for which they requested a grant.
