2011 Construction Bids for the Aiken County Public Schools Paving Project

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Bids were received for the Aiken County Public Schools Paving Project 2011 June 29, 2011 at 2:00 p.m. and publicly opened. Bids were received from eight bidders with Contractors South, Inc. submitting the lowest bid of \$190,500.00. Base bid includes overlay at Aiken Elementary and J.D. Lever Elementary. Alternate #1 Hammond Hill Elementary (\$40,730.00); Alternate #2 Silver Bluff High (\$3,950.00); Alternate #3 Aiken High (\$54,641.00); Alternate #4 Gloverville Elementary (\$9,723.00); Alternate #5 North Augusta High (\$14,470.00). The engineer evaluated the projects with input from the administration to generate a scope of work based on the approved 2011-2012 Five Year Facility Improvement Plan. The 2011-2012 budget for District-Wide Paving and Erosion Control is \$411,000.00. The design, printing, advertising and 5% contingency amounts to \$53,787.84. Total project cost for 2011 Construction Bids for the Aiken County Public Schools Paving Project is \$314,014.00.
