SUBJECT:

2014-2015 Title I Support Funds

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

According to the Elementary and Secondary Act Waiver approved in July of 2012, schools that receive a D or F on the state report card are classified as Title I Support Schools and must develop a plan to address specific strategies to improve academic performance. The following nine schools were given allocations for this purpose, totaling \$529,167 – Busbee Corbett Elementary/Middle, Byrd Elementary, Clearwater Elementary, LBC Middle, Leavelle McCampbell Middle, Midland Valley Preparatory Charter, Mossy Creek Elementary, Oakwood-Windsor Elementary, and Redcliffe Elementary.

ADMINISTRATIVE CONSIDERATION:

The Division of Instruction and Accountability worked with school administration and Title I planning teams to develop strategies to address identified needs. These funds will be used for professional development for teachers and administrators, technology hardware and software, certified tutors, Fountas and Pinnell leveled literacy intervention kits and training, field trips, and leveled library books.

RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the use of the Title I Support funds and the implementation of the strategies for the 2014-2015 school year.
