The course is designed to develop in the students the habits of analysis, understanding, and appreciation for myth in a disciplined and creative manner. Students will investigate the patterns and archetypes of world mythology by reading a variety of ancient myths as well as plays, short stories, poems, and novels that utilize themes and characters inspired by myth and will write in both expository and creative modes. Students will study the mythology of ancient Greece and Rome as well as Scandinavia, Egypt, Africa, Japan, Europe, and the Americas. Emphasis is on the influence of such works on our own literature, culture, and language. There are two main objectives. One is to read a variety of myths and legends focusing on the content of literary elements.
