#### SUBJECT:

S.C. Department of Education High-Intensity Tutoring Grant Award – Aiken County Public School District - FY26

### BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

South Carolina Proviso 1A.72 (High-Intensity Tutoring) authorized the South Carolina Department of Education (SCDE) to provide funds to school districts and community partners to pilot academic support programs providing high-dosage, low-ratio tutoring to students in mathematics and reading by compensated tutors. Aiken County Public School District (ACPSD) was chosen to participate in the pilot during the 2024-2025 school year.

ACPSD was notified recently that the district was awarded the High Intensity Tutoring (HIT) grant again for the 2025-2026 school year. The grant, in the amount of \$1,472,760.00, will be used to continue activities included in the initial grant along with extending tutoring/remedial activities to the middle and high school levels. Funds will be used for a variety of services including, but not limited to, the purchase of educational technology software, professional development, instructional materials, student supplies, and extra duty pay beyond the regular school day.

### ADMINISTRATIVE CONSIDERATION:

The Division of Instruction has evaluated the goals and objectives and finds them to be consistent with district goals.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

Approve the S.C. Department of Education High-Intensity Tutoring Grant Award to Aiken County Public School District in the amount of \$1,472,760.00 and the receipt of funds and adjustment to the FY26 Special Revenue Fund to reflect the amount of the grant award and expenditures.
