SUBJECT:

Public Education Partners (PEP) of Aiken County Grant Awards to the Aiken County Public School District – FY24

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Aiken County Public School District has been given a \$5,517.65 in grant awards from the Public Education Partners (PEP) of Aiken County. The funds received will be used to fund 12 teacher grant awards. After evaluating all of the grant applications submitted to PEP, twelve projects were selected to receive awards. These grants total \$5,517.65 [\$2,204.75 are related to STEAM], and funds are to be used by the awardee teachers to carry out the projects for which they requested a grant.
