SUBJECT:

Public Education Partners Grant to Aiken County Career and Technology Center – FY12

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Aiken County Career and Technology Center was awarded a \$7,500 Public Education Partners Grant. This grant was made possible by a donation to PEP from Kimberly Clark. Funds from this grant will be used to support the CTE Career Cluster Survey Course. This Innovative Career and Technology Education (CTE) course will provide opportunities for the students to learn the introductory fundamentals of CTE courses and to apply academics in a project based classroom setting while gaining skills that will affect their quality of life.
