SUBJECT:

Funding Flexibility for the Quarter and Year Ending June 30, 2022

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Under provisos 1.25, 1.30 and 1A.14 for Fiscal Year 2021 – 2022, all school districts and special schools of this State may transfer and expend funds "to ensure the delivery of academic and arts instruction to students." Flexibility guidelines require that each district's board and superintendent certify the specific flexibility actions taken. The certification must be in writing, signed by the board chairman and superintendent, and delivered electronically to the State Superintendent of Education. The SC Department of Education will subsequently forward the information to various legislators and legislative bodies. The certification must be posted on the district's website.

ADMINISTRATIVE CONSIDERATION:

The SCDE typically allows unspent EIA and State grant funds to be carried over for one year. At times, the District must flex unspent allocations to the General Fund to avoid having to repay those amounts back to the State at the end of the carryover period.

The SCDE had allowed a second carryover year Covid-19 impacts for the two previous years. The second carryover year no longer applies. This flex requests moves carryover funds unspent from the year ended June 30, 2021.
