School Information:

- Elem
 - 19 of 21 having trouble filling absences in the last week.
- Middle
 - RSM – using the subs they have for multiple classes and all day, for example when the sub is on a planning period, they move him/her to cover another class.
 - PKMS – on 11/16 had 5 teacher absences and only 2 subs
 - NAMS –
 - 10/25 = 42% fill rate
 - 11/1 = 62% fill rate
 - 11/8 = 41% fill rate
 - 11/15 = 50% fill rate
 - **One class without a sub for two weeks
 - KMS – 11/13 had 2 positions not filled
 - LBC – 15% fill rate over the last two weeks
- High
 - SBHS – regular problems filling absences, uses teachers who are on planning periods
 - AHS – 11/13 had 13 unfilled absences of their 30, 11/15 had 6 unfilled
 - RSM – uses aides and teachers on planning on a regular basis to cover

- ASA – 11/13 & 11/16 had to unfilled absences
- ACCTC – Mr. Lott has had to sub several times last week
- NAHS – regularly has to use teachers on planning and use aides to cover open absences
- MVHS – 11/13 had 13 unfilled absences
- WSH – had to use teachers on planning and the P and AP last week.
