SUBJECT:

Monthly Financial Report for the Period Ended December 31, 2024

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Business Services Department submits monthly financials for Board review, consideration, and acceptance.

ADMINISTRATIVE CONSIDERATION:

A breakdown of General Fund revenue and expenditures is presented for review. The attached report reflects budgeted amounts, current and year-to-date amounts, and the remaining balance. Revenue and expenditures through December 31, 2024, comprised 42% and 46%, respectively, of annual budget amounts. These percentages are in line with normal expectations through this time of year.

The packet also includes information on 1% Education Capital Improvement Sales & Use Tax collections (reflecting the current and two previous years). Since inception through December 2024, sales tax collections totaled more than \$226.7 million. Collections to date exceed the original 10-year projection by approximately \$38 million, with two months remaining. The sales tax sunsets February 28, 2025.
