FIRST READING RECAP

- Impacts of enrollment decreases on many allocations
- No tax increase
- BSC at \$2,500
- Step for all eligible employees, 26th teacher step, no COLA
- Retirement (to 23%), health insurance (by 0.8%) increases
- Lower PTRs in 1st, 4th and 5th
- 190-day high school counselors increases to 200 days
- Removal of charter school allocations
- Various other shifts, updates

SECOND READING HIGHLIGHTS

- Step for all eligible employees, 26th teacher step, no COLA
 - \$1,000 increase per teacher scale cell (Senate version)
- 5% bus driver increase (Senate version)
- Health insurance increase rose from 0.8% to 2.6%
- BSC at \$2,516 (EFA up \$344,599 from First Reading)
- Additional funding State Aid to Classrooms Teacher Salary fund (up \$1,876,317 from First Reading)
- Additional <u>non-recurring</u> Aid-to-Districts funding (up \$59,1831 from First Reading)

OTHER

- State <u>has not</u> finalized its budget
 - Possibly mid-to-late June
 - Significant difference between House and Senate on teacher pay, also the increase in bus pay
- District will continue to monitor State budget process
- Amendments to Second/Final Reading are likely
- District salary schedule revision might be necessary
