4. Elementary Tier 3 Behavior Intervention Program (Dr. Foster)

In recent years we have seen a trend in increasingly challenging behaviors in a small population of our elementary students across the country. Interventions at the school-level have often been less than successful and may be contributing to an over identification of students with disabilities. Surveyed teachers indicated that classroom management of students exhibiting extreme behavior is the most challenging aspect of their job. Teacher Forum and Elementary Principals have also noted that a significant portion of the school day is devoted to supporting students in crisis.
